Sampling Design- The detailed sampling plan is shown below. The sample in the present study consisted of 300 adolescents (150 girls and 150 boys) between 16 to 18 years. They were selected through random sampling technique. The sample was bifurcated into two groups 150 male and 150 female.

Sampling Technique: - The subjects were randomly selected from school by selecting every third male and female from the class register of 9th to 12th standard. The students below 13years of age or above 18years of age were dropped from the sample. Thus 50% male and 50%female student were assigned to two groups. 5 girls' school and 5 boys School were selected from Dehradun city randomly through lottery system.
