He says:

The name 'progressive writer' is defective - an artist or a writer is by his very nature progressive. But perhaps it is necessary to use this qualifying word because progress has a different meaning for different people. For us 'progressive' is that which creates in us the power to act; which makes us examine those subjective and objective causes that have brought us

to such a pass of sterility and degeneration; and finally which helps us to overcome and remove those causes, and become men once again.... We must, resolutely, give up writing those love romances with which our periodicals are flooded. We have no time to waste over sentimental art. The only art which has value for us today is that which is dynamic and leads to action. (Premchand, Munshi p.83)
