The GST Council(32nd) meeting was held at New Delhi and led by Union Finance Minister-Shri Arun Jaitley..

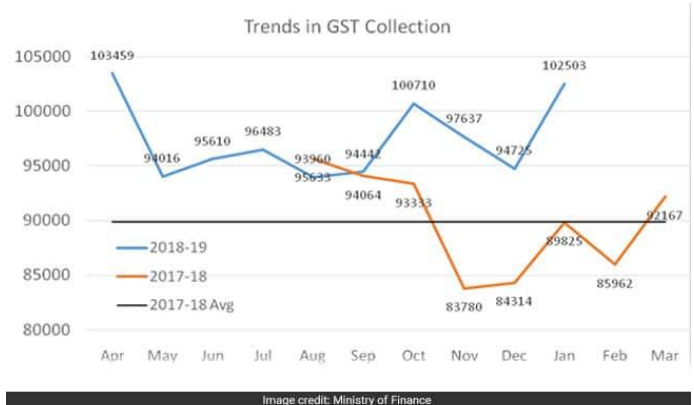
The key purposes of the 32nd GST Council meeting are as per the following:

- GST enlistment limit expanded from Rs 20 lakhs to Rs 40 lakhs for providers of products.

- For specialist organizations other than the provider of eatery administrations and cooking service, the total Turnover limit is Rs 50 lakhs and the Tax rate is fixed at 6%.
- No rate cuts were declared this time.
- Natural Calamity cess increment up to 1% for as long as 2 years will be charged for provisions made.
