14 banks having stores of Rs. 50 crores or more were nationalized by Government in July 1969. In the year 1980, government gained extra six banks with stores of more than Rs. 200 crores. Government nationalized commercial banks with the significant objectives of giving social government assistance, controlling of private restraining infrastructures, extensions of banking, diminishing the local lopsidedness, arrangement of need sector loaning and formation of banking propensities among the individuals.

The means taken by legislature of India to control the banks in the nation secured following advances:

- In year 1949, legislature of India Enacted Banking Regulation Act.

- Year 1955, saw nationalization of State Bank of India and in the year 1959 SBI backups was nationalized.
- In the year 1961, protection spread was reached out to stores.
- In the year 1969, other 14 significant banks were nationalized.
- Credit Guarantee Corporation was made in the year 1971
- In the year 1975, Regional Rural Banks were made.
- Year 1980, saw nationalization of banks with stores more than 200 crores.

In 1990's, New Generation educated banks developed as the aftereffect of approach of advancement (wherein modest number of private banks were given permit) presented by Narsimha Rao government.

4. Review of literature

M. Muthukumar and K. Guru (2016) examined the organizational climate and its measurements in 41 branches in Chennai of KarurVysya Banks.
