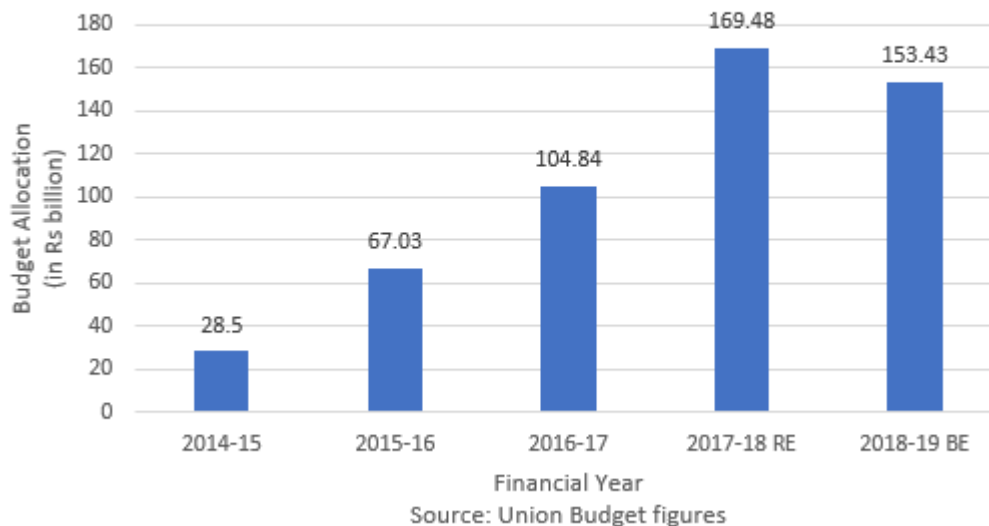
3. Case Study of Hisar District

- We find in these villages that in every house water availability is in good condition by waterworks facilities. approximately every day 1.5 to 2 hours taps running openly although 40 -50 minutes is enough for every day .thus approximately 4 -5 thousand litter water is openly flowing in streets by some village .
- And toilets are already 99 % in every house of these villages. But approximately 27 % male and female is going in open defecation during dawn and morning. There is only main rudimentary thinking that everybody should go for toilets in open area so that they can take pure oxygen and take benefits of morning walk.

- And mostly toilets tank (well) in every house had dug up to water table so that tank cannot fill by wastes in future.
- We find in every village that main streets of study area villages that is occupied by pile of woods, heap of wastes, dung house and heavy instrument of agriculture.
- And some streets is distort by heavy vehicle and water pipe has leaked and breakdown. Due to this problem we can these streets covered by polluted water remains all time and originate some dangerous diseases and bad smell.
