It was the Nightingale and Intrusion and Other Stories were distributed in the year 1993. Her three most recent books are, A Matter of Time (1996), Small Remedies (2000) and The Stone Women (2000). In her composition profession of 30 years Deshpande distributed her tenth and late novel, In the Country of Deceit (2008).

The most recent novel, *The Zigzag Way* (2004), she left from her well-known regions and set the story in Mexico. She has likewise distributed two accumulations of short stories – *Games of Twilight and Other Stories* (1978) and *Star Dust and Other Stories* (2001).

In 1986 she was a Visiting Fellow at Colleges including Smith, Mount Holyoke and Girton College and Cambridge University. She was an individual from the warning board for English of the National Academy of Letters in Delhi, starting in 1972, referred to in India as The Sahitya Akademi which granted Desai, its tip Prize in 1979. In 1993 Massachusetts Institute of Technology delegated Desai as the principal Professor of Writing in English for over 20 years. She was likewise Fellow of the Royal Society of Literature and assigned as a Member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters. Thrice she was short-recorded for the esteemed Booker Prize. She was regarded with 'Padmashri' grant by the Government of India.
