The wedding closes with the man of the hour tying the Mangalsutra around the lady of the hour's neck.

After the festivals and games are the most heart contacting minutes for the merriments when the lady of the hour needs to express bye to her folks and tears moving down the cheeks is an ordinary situation in these minutes.
