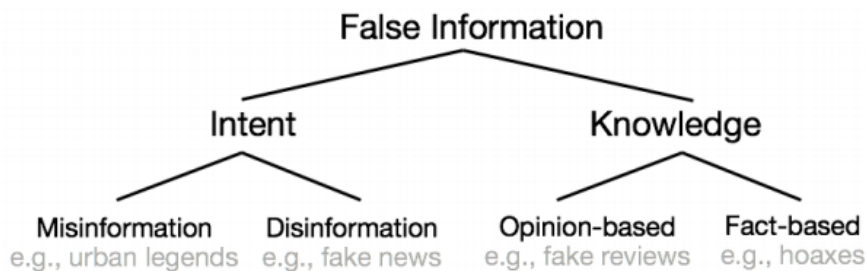


Figure 1 types of false information
