7. FINDINGS

- As per SEBI, all recorded banks need to follow the arrangements of Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement, which explicitly manages Corporate Governance. Out of the 27 banks studied, all the banks replied in the positive to this inquiry.

Out of the 27 banks overviewed, 26 banks i.e 9 private banks, 9 unfamiliar banks and 8 nationalized banks replied in the positive to this inquiry. Just 1 nationalized bank replied in the negative.
- Out of the 27 banks studied, just 24 banks for example 8 private banks 7 nationalized banks and 9 unfamiliar banks have been evaluated by an outer office.
- Out of the 27 banks studied, all banks compose programs identifying with corporate administration for their chiefs.
- The number of banks that vibe that Corporate Governance would achieve the ideal degree of decency, straightforwardness and responsibility in banks.
- Out of the 27 banks reviewed, just 21 banks for example 6 nationalized banks, 7 private banks and 8 unfamiliar banks feel that selection of corporate administration rehearses has brought about expanded straightforwardness and responsibility.
- Out of the 27 banks overviewed, all banks feel that selection of corporate administration rehearses has brought about expanded investor esteem.
- Out of the 27 banks reviewed, just 20 for example 4 nationalized banks, 8 private banks and 8

unfamiliar banks feel that appropriation of corporate administration rehearses has brought about expanded duty of the directorate.

- Most of the banks felt that divulgence guidelines in India are nearly settle for what is most convenient option.
